Guidelines, Terms and Conditions

Pride Parade: Saturday June 24, 2023 9am-12pm

- 1. Application and Acceptance.** Lethbridge Pride Fest Society reserves the right to approve or reject this Application. If approved, written acceptance of the Application will be sent to you by email at the email address provided in the application. Upon acceptance, further details will be provided to you.
- 2. Parade Lineup.** Placement in the parade lineup is at the discretion of the Lethbridge Pride Fest Society's Parade Coordinator(s). Your lineup assignment will be provided to you on the parade day. If you would like to make a special request, please contact the Parade Coordinator(s) to request additional accommodations. Accommodations will be at the discretion of the Parade Coordinator(s).
- 3. Float Regulations.** All parade floats must comply with City of Lethbridge's parade guidelines and the *Alberta Traffic Safety Act* ("Act"). You are responsible for ensuring these regulations are met. We reserve the right to reject the float if the float does not meet the specifications received from the City of Lethbridge or does not comply with the Act.
- 4. Payment.** Payment can be made through our invoicing system or by cheque payable to "Lethbridge Pride Fest Society." If paying by cheque, please email treasurer@lethbridgepride.com to arrange pickup or delivery.
- 5. Cancellation.** In the event that you are no longer able to participate in the event, cancellation will need to be received by June 1, 2023 in order to qualify for a full refund. Cancellations received after June 1, 2023 will not receive a refund. Please be aware that refunds will not be provided for weather, electrical outage, or attendance.
- 6. Agreement.** In consideration of Lethbridge Pride Fest Society allowing the Applicant the opportunity to participate in the parade, such participation is undertaken by the Applicant, its representatives, employees and participants at their sole and absolute risk.

The Applicant further agrees as follows:

- (a) to waive any and all claims that they have or may have against the Society, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers and agents (all of whom are collectively referred to "Released Parties"), arising directly or indirectly from our participation in the parade; and

(b) to release the Released Parties from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense that we may suffer or that any employee or participant may suffer as a result of our participation in the parade, due to any cause, including any wrongful act or omission, negligence, breach of contract or breach of any statutory or other duty of care on the part of the Released Parties.

This Agreement shall be effective and binding on the heirs, executors, administrator and assigns of the Applicant.
